1. Review FY22 Priorities for Community Partnership Agreements

a. FY22 NOFA – Purpose of CPA funds

The primary purpose of the funding is to provide resources at the local level to strengthen community-based services to children, youth, and families with a focus on increasing childhood well-being, with intentional efforts to address childhood trauma and Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs), as well as race equity.

b. FY22 NOFA – Funding Opportunity Description

The Children’s Cabinet has adopted three overall themes that support its collective work as supported by this NOFA: race equity; Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and trauma-informed practices; and research-based practices. These themes or “lenses” should be applied to all programs/strategies proposed for FY22 as follows:

1. Race Equity - All programs/strategies must incorporate intentional efforts to address race equity issues, including:

a. The strategies that the applicant will incorporate to

reduce/eliminate race equity issues within b. How the applicant’s race/equity efforts will support and inform planning, assessment, implementation and evaluation of the program; and,

c. A discussion of the most recent local race equity data with citations.
