- 1. The meeting was called to order at 2:05 pm. The purpose of the meeting was to review and rank applications submitted for the Career Pathways Request for Proposals in order to recommend to the Board of Directors an applicant for FY22 funding. Building African American Minds (BAAM) and Neighborhood Service Center submitted applications.
- 2. It was noted that committee member Samantha Martinez was not attending or participating in the review for this RFP due to her professional relationship with one of the applicants.
- 3. Jazmine Paxon made a motion to go into closed session based on General Provisions Act 3-305(b)(14). William Johnson seconded the motion. All were in favor; none opposed. The committee moved into closed session at 2:10pm.

# PRESIDING OFFICER'S WRITTEN STATEMENT FOR CLOSING A MEETING ("CLOSING STATEMENT") UNDER THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT (General Provisions Article § 3-305)

with Instructions

**Instructions to presiding officer:** To meet in a closed session under the Act, the public body must first meet in open session, after providing proper notice. Make sure that the open session is attended by a member designated to receive open meetings training. If a designated member cannot attend, complete the Compliance Checklist. If the public body has never designated a member for training, it must do so **before closing the session**.

Before closing the session, take two steps: (1) conduct a recorded vote on a motion to close; and (2) make a written "closing" statement. If the public body might return to open session afterwards, be sure to tell the public that. During the closed session, keep the discussion topics within the confines of the closing statement. After the closed session, the events of the closed session must be disclosed in the next open-session minutes.

The top part of this form is a model closing statement. It has two sides. Before closing the open session, complete items 1 through 4 on this form or in any writing with the same information. If someone pre-prepared the form for you, make sure it reflects the public body's own intended topics and reasons for closing the meeting. A member of the public may inspect the closing statement at the time of the closing and may object to the decision to close the meeting. Once the meeting is closed, the closing statement sets the agenda and may not be changed.

The bottom part of the form is a worksheet that provides a checklist of the disclosures that must be made in the next open-session minutes. The worksheet is not part of the closing statement.
