History

Beginnings

LMBs were established in response to SB 588 and HB 1055 to reform the State's Human Service Delivery System for children and families in Maryland.

July 1997

Talbot Family Network was established in July of 1997

LMBs started as a regional entity in 1990 but soon divided into individual Boards for each county.

An effort to change the way services were provided to children and families in their communities

Charged with identifying local needs and targeting resources for the community

Focus on increasing local authority to plan, implement, and monitor children and family services
