MEETING MINUTES

FY26 COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT – Budget Modification Request

Nancy Andrew deferred this request to the February meeting awaiting information from current program vendors about their budgets.

FY27 COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

Local Management Board’s are awaiting release of the FY27 Notice of Funding Available, which came out around the New Year in prior cycles.

FY26 ENOUGH CAPACITY BUILDING FUNDS

Nancy reported that FY26 contracting with the GOC was completed in December. The grant period ends 9/30/26. Funds of \$52,026 are being used as follow:

- **Talbot County Hunger Coalition**
Contract with Due East for coalition alignment and capacity building
- **Collective Impact**
Contract with Due East for coaching and project guidance
- **Groundwater Training**
Contract with REI for the 2-day training in June 2026

COLLECTIVE IMPACT TALBOT - Other local initiatives / levers impacting poverty:

Sharon Pepukayi gave an update on the Talbot County Read Alliance pilot. Pre-assessments set for tomorrow with Easton Elementary School students. Recruitment of reading mentors from among Easton High School students is underway. Depending on how the pilot phase goes this semester, the program may be expanded to other TCPS elementary schools.
