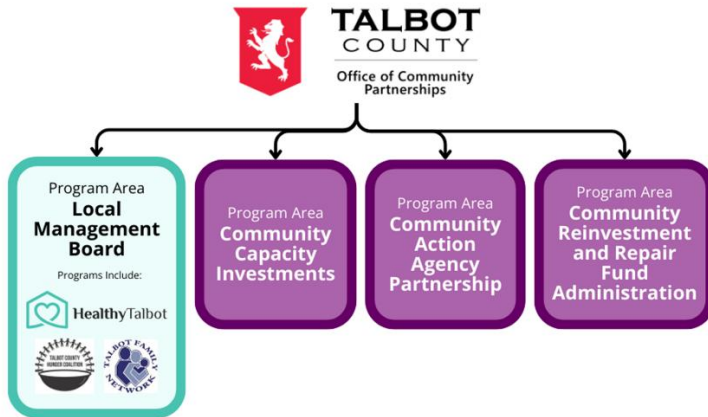

FY27 COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

FY27 work plans and budgets are due to the state by 4/24/26. Board members will vote on TFN’s draft proposal at their April meeting.

OFFICE OF COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP

Nancy announced that the Talbot County Council has established a new Office of Community Partnerships of which the Local Management Board and the Community Reinvestment and Repair Funds are components. Nancy has been named Director of this office. The county is adding a project manager position.



COLLECTIVE IMPACT TALBOT - Other local initiatives / levers impacting poverty:

Rural Health Transformation

Dr. Fahmi Fahmi gave an overview of the state’s [Rural Health Transformation Project](#) within the Department of Health. With oversight from the Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services, Maryland has been awarded \$168/year for 5 years, contingent on performance. Maryland’s RHTP plan is built around three pillars:

- Transform the Rural Health Workforce (\$26 million)
- Promote Sustainable Access and Innovative Care (\$126 million)
- Empower Rural Marylanders to Eat for Health (\$16 million)

This is rolling out alongside state-led initiatives including **AHEAD Population Health** with which there is some alignment.

Board members also discussed needs and challenges arising from ongoing Immigration and Customs Enforcement activity in the county.
